## WHY RECYCLE?

Recycling reduces waste in landfills, conserves natural resources, saves energy, and is good for Georgia businesses. There are multiple options for residents to recycle in Smyrna or within 30 minutes of the city.

For the most basic recycling option, the City of Smyrna provides curbside recycling for residents within the city limits for the following materials:

- Plastics #1 and #2
- Metal and aluminum cans
- Cardboard and paper
- Cartons
- Hefty EnergyBags (plastics #4-#7)

For more extensive recycling, the City of Smyrna Recycling Center (3475 Lake Drive, Smyrna) takes all of the materials accepted curbside plus:

- All types of metal items
- Cooking oil
- Motor oil/antifreeze
- Glass (food grade bottles and jars only)
- Rechargeable batteries
- Fluorescent tubes
- Books
- Ink jet cartridges
- Wearable clothing
